



## Dennis Dwayne "Denny" Hagan

January 29, 1949 - May 3, 2022

Dennis "Denny" Hagan, age 73 from Altoona, Iowa was born January 29, 1949, in Des Moines, Iowa to Paul and Betty Watters Hagan. Denny went to the arms of Jesus to be free from pain and suffering from a skin disease and cancer, on May 3, 2022, at Mercy Medical Centre in Des Moines Iowa.
