



## Gregory S. Wycoff

November 3, 1971 - April 22, 2015

Gregory S. Wycoff, 43, passed away on April 22, 2015 after a long , courageous battle with brain cancer. He was born to Steve and Jeannine Wycoff on November 3, 1971 and raised on a small farm in Nevada, Iowa.

Greg graduated from Nevada High School, earning 15 out of 16 letters for his athletic accomplishments. He attended Simpson College on a football Scholarship and obtained his Bachelors of Arts degree and Greg continued his education while employed with Maytag and achieved a Master's Degree in Organizational Management from the University of Phoenix.

Greg received great joy coaching his children in their athletic activities. He will always be remembered for his positive attitude, strong faith, and inspirational life experiences.
