“Kimmie and I grew up together. Our parents were best friends, and our brothers were almost the same age (2 years younger than us). Since we went to different schools, most weekends were overnight events spent at their house in Ankeny or ours in Des Moines. Our parents were sort of interchangeable. I remember Sundays right after morning church service, piling into the car and stopping for donuts on the way home before heading to the house where we'd proceed to fight over the comic section (girls vs. boys). She was the one who taught me to mix mashed potatoes and cottage cheese together (which I still eat). We sang in the junior high choir together at Epworth UM Church, and sat together during Sunday worship service, where our parents gave us the "look" from the adult choir loft when we weren't paying attention to the sermon (it was always the boys' fault). I also remember standing around the piano and singing Christmas songs with our moms. Once we got snowed OUT of Des Moines during the huge surprise snowstorm in April 1973. Our church youth group spent several days with college students at Morningside College in Sioux City while on a visit to the campus. After 2-3 days, our parents came to get us, but by then, the snow at home was all gone, and we had incredible memories of a great week "on our own." There was the time Kimmie and I helped as "servers and clean-up" for a Christmas party at my house that our parents were hosting. This eventually involved some "almost" empty wine glasses and an unopened box of Andes Mints (some details have been excluded to protect the innocent). We laughed, we cried, we conspired, we loved. And yes, like I said...we grew up together. After high school, we were together less. Time and life circumstances changed and then pulled at our relationship. And yet, every time we saw each other, it seemed like time had stood still.

*Everything had changed...and yet nothing had changed.*

*She was soft-hearted and strong-willed. She was stubborn, compassionate, loyal and fun. She loved her family; her husband and daughters so much, there was nothing she wouldn't do to protect them, to make them happy. She knew the meaning of real*

*love and was able to give it freely.*

*Kimmie...you're home now and out of pain. For that we are grateful to God, while at the same time we're grieving from this open wound. We will never fill the hole in our hearts that belongs to you. But we'll see you again in Glory. Save us a place.*

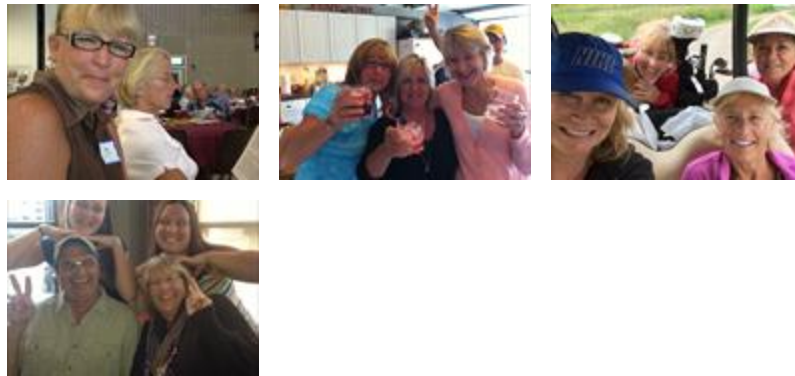
