During her teaching years she was also a tutor, mentor and a Special Olympics coach, impacting countless lives. community.

While teaching was so important to her, being a mom was her favorite job! Linda always made sure her family was together. Family was the center of Linda's being and she was the best at every single phase of motherhood. She lugged 3 young girls to the fields to watch their dad coach, gave life advice during the dramatic teen years and allowed her daughters to learn from their mistakes. Linda taught and guided her daughters up until her very last days and she will continue to shape their lives in the best possible ways. They will be selfless, compassionate, and strong just like her.

Linda retired from Ankeny schools in 2010, with her early retirement package came her first granddaughter Lyla JoLin. She was blessed with two more grandchildren, Olive Irene and Harris "Hank" Michael. Being a grandma fulfilled her purpose and she was happiest when her house was filled with toys, laughter and life.

Linda fought through numerous medical challenges for three years to stay here for her family. Her family witnessed miracles and watched in awe as she pushed through setback after setback.
